**AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
FOR E911 SERVICES AND REIMBURSEMENT OF ELIGIBLE EXPENSES**

KC-278-18-D

This Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement for E911 Services and Reimbursement of Eligible Expenses is made and entered into pursuant to RCW 39.34.080 between Kitsap County (County) and Kitsap 911. In consideration of the mutual benefits and covenants contained herein, the parties agree that their Agreement, numbered as Kitsap County Contract No. KC-278-18, and executed on September 10, 2018, shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The following new language will be added to the RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the County will be entering into a contract with the Washington State Military Department (Department) for reimbursement of eligible expenses concerning operation of E911 services, said contract being attached hereto as Attachment F, "SECO COUNTY Coordinator Professional Development (CPD) Contract SFY 2023 (E23-018);" and

WHEREAS, the County desires to amend its Interlocal Agreement (KC-278-18) with Kitsap 911 such that Kitsap 911 will perform those services, tasks, duties, and obligations set out in Attachment F to this Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement, and Kitsap County will pass-through the funds to be received under Attachment F to Kitsap 911 in exchange for Kitsap 911's performance and completion in a satisfactory manner the services, tasks, duties, and obligations set out in this Amendment and in Attachment F, RCW 35.21.730 through RCW 35.21.759, and Chapter 2.110 Kitsap County Code.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of the Agreement, SCOPE OF SERVICES, is amended to read as follows:

Kitsap 911 shall perform the services, tasks, duties, and obligations set out in Attachments A, B, C, D, E and F, including the furnishing of all materials and equipment necessary, as described in the Agreement and in Attachments A, B, C, D, E and F.

SECTION 3. Section 2 of the Agreement, TERM, is amended to read as follows:

This Agreement shall be effective July 1, 2017 through August 15, 2023.

SECTION 4. Section 3, Compensation and Method of Payment, is amended to read as follows:

The County will authorize the Department to pay directly to Kitsap 911 those sums identified in Section VIII of Attachments A, B, C, D, E and F. The County shall make no other payments to Kitsap 911, and compensation to Kitsap 911 under this Agreement and Attachments A, B, C, D, E and F shall be limited to those funds allowed and paid by the Department pursuant to Attachments A, B, C, D, E and F.

In the event any funds are recaptured by the Department as allowed in Attachments A, B, C, D, E and F, within 30 days of demand Kitsap 911 shall reimburse the County all amounts recaptured, including any costs incurred by Kitsap County, including attorney fees, as provided in the recapture provisions in Attachments A, B, C, D, E and F.

SECTION 5. Section 8, Subsection B, Termination for Cause is Amended as follows:

B. Termination for Cause. If Kitsap 911 fails to perform in the manner called for in the Agreement or any Amendments to this Agreement, or if Kitsap 911 fails to comply with any other provisions of the Agreement or any Amendments to the Agreement and fails to correct such noncompliance within five (5) days written notice thereof, the County may terminate the Agreement for cause. Termination shall be effected by serving a notice of termination on Kitsap 911 setting forth the manner in which Kitsap 911 is in default.

SECTION 6. Except as expressly provided in this Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the original Agreement, and subsequent amendments, addenda, or modifications thereto, remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. Filing. This Amendment shall be filed with the Kitsap County Auditor following execution.
